NSWRRA (Seniors) Regrading Policy

This document outlines the Process in which MOs are Re-Graded within the NSWRRA Grading Structure

NSWRRA D Panel

All New MOs with no previous experience, or experience in MO Juniors (u18s) game only will be graded at D level.

NSWRRA C Panel

MOs will be re-graded to C-Grade having been seen on at least 3 games by a MOD, with at least 2 MODs agreeing that they are competent enough to MO Senior Rugby. Final approval will be made by the DAC.

NSWRRA B Panel

The NSWRRA B Panel will be reviewed by the DAC on a yearly basis. Entry into the squad will take into consideration recommendations from at least 2 MODs, as well as approval by the MOD lead of SSDS, the MOD lead of SSG and the DAC.

MOs who move into B Panel must have demonstrated Performance-Level characteristics in at least two of the following environments:

- 1. NSWJRU State Championships (U16s or U18s)
- 2. A B-Level NSWRRA Game, seen by at least two independent MODs, one of which is a member of the DAC
- 3. A Senior Finals series, benchmarked against a B-level MO

MOs in B Panel are expected to meet minimum Fitness requirements and be committed to ongoing education and development in a Squad.

Members who drop down from B Panel will be notified by the Appointments and Gradings person on the DAC in consultation with their Squad Leader.

NSWRRA A Panel (Shute Shield Panel)

The NSWRRA A Panel is reviewed on a yearly basis by the Shute Shield Panel Management Group.

Entry to this Group requires approval from the Shute Shield Management Group who monitors the performance of MOs from the NSWRRA B Panel in consultation with the DAC.

Members who drop down from the Shute Shield Panel will be notified by the Shute Shield Squad Leader.
